- **For the whole weekend** (Friday after supper - Sunday Early afternoon).

Cost: \$65/adult, \$55/youth (age 12 - 18), \$30/child (age 6-11),

and Free/child (age 5 & under)

- **For Saturday only** (Includes Lunch & Supper)

Cost: \$30/adult, \$25/youth (age 12 - 18), \$15/child (age 6-11),

and Free/child (age 5 & under)

- **For Saturday only** (No Meals)

Cost: \$10/day charge for age 6+.

- **For Sunday Only** our service will start at 11 a.m.

Cost: Lunch by donation

### **Accommodation Fee Options:**

- Stay in the provided dorms (no additional cost).

Dorm style room for your family with bunk beds.

Will definitely keep you warm & dry and has washroom facilities.

Will need to bring your own bedding.

- Stay in a tent with no power (no additional cost).

- Stay in a tent with power (\$15/night).
