EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY - Bookkeeper

LCBC is currently looking to fill the supportive role of Bookkeeper. This is primarily a data-entry and records management position and will require up to 5 hours weekly and is a paid staff position. The main duties are outlined below.

The Bookkeeper reports directly to the Treasurer and will coordinate duties and hours of work with the Treasurer. General duties of the bookkeeper are outlined below, some of which may be subject to modification:

- Set the schedule and oversee the work of the tellers
- Enter Teller summaries (double-checking the count).
- Deposit the bank deposit each week.
- Post all incoming funds to accounts program (including e-transfers).
- Reconcile bank account on a monthly basis. Prepare pay cheques (or Etransfers) and expenditure cheques based on the information provided by the Treasurer.
- Notify Treasurer and Adminstrating Officer when cheques are ready to sign.
